1.	The target group	7 - 14 years old
2.	The goal of the workshop	Encourage teachers and students to use plasticine as a material of painting.
3.	Tasks of the workshop:	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Acquaint the participants with the potential work material - plasticine.</li> <li>2. Encourage participants to use the colourful plasticine to make a picture</li> </ol>
4.	Expected results	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Participants of the workshop have got the new approach of painting.</li> <li>2. Participants of the workshop developed imagination and flexibility by experimentation with the material</li> </ol>
5.	The plan of the workshop:  60 min.	<u>5 min.</u> Talks. Introducing of theme of the workshop (the new, unusual way of painting by using the plasticine) <u>5 min.</u> Exploring the plasticine (the way of spreading it on the cardboard, mixing colours, different ways of making effects by sticks, and other) <u>5 min.</u> Choice of the subject and actuality of the theme displaying in the visual work of art (the influence of local artists work, traditional art, impressions of season and other) <u>40 min.</u> Practical work (making the picture according to theme and prepared materials) <u>5 min.</u> Job analysis, summary conclusions - small exhibition and other
